

Rules

Youth that sign-up for a program must commit to attend the program. Youth that are at the Club and do not attend their program(s) will be ineligible to sign up for future enrichment programs.

Youth that are disruptive or disrespect club staff will be removed from class and can, at the discretion of Club staff, be sent home. Continued disruptive behavior can result in a suspension from all Club activities.

Willful destruction of Club property will result in youth being removed from class and can, at the discretion of Club staff, have the youth sent home. Parent (s) and or guardian(s) will be responsible for any and all replacement costs.

General Information

The Club is offering its members many exciting opportunities this fall! Classes in art, technology, sports and other exciting areas will offer youth in grades 1 through 6 the chance to explore activities that interest them. All members will continue to engage in the core daily activities the club offers such as Power Hour, Gym, Gameroom, and Technology lab.

Classes will start the week of January 9th and run through the first week of March. Members will need to register no later than Friday, December 30. Classes are extremely limited and sign-ups are on a first come, first served basis.

Members will generally be unable to register for courses past this deadline. Completed registration forms must be handed in at front desk. Many enrichment courses will b re-offered in the Spring session so if a member faces the dilemma of wanting to take two separate programs which overlap they will generally have the option to take one of the programs in a future session.

Members are required to sign-up in advance for our after school enrichment programs with the commitment that they will plan on attending their program sessions during the Boys & Girls Club of Meriden's Winter 2017 program term. Our Winter 2017 program term **begins Monday**, **January 9**, **2016** and will last for 8 weeks with MOST classes **concluding around March 1**, **2017**. Enrichment courses will not take place during Holiday/vactaion breaks even when the Club is open, as these days we will follow a special non-school day schedule.



SPORTS

Archery Thursdays 4:00 or 5:00 Grades 4 & up
Target archery will be taught to youth by US Archery Level II Coach Dominic
Pereyo. Youth will have the opportunity to attain a ranking in the Club's 13
Level Ranking System. Note: Youth MUST have taken a beginner's lesson
prior to registering for this class.

Volleyball Thursdays 4:10-4:50 Grades 4, 5 & 6
Volleyball Thursdays 4:50-5:30 Grades 7 & up

Learn the basics of volleyball from Coach Sammy, former High School and College player. This class will take place in the lower gym. Youth that enjoy this class should consider joining our Youth Volleyball League.

Self Defense Wednesday 4:10-4:50 Grades 1-3
Self Defense Wednesday 4:50-5:30 Grades 4-6

Taught by senior members of Valentin Karate, this class is not only filled with action packed fitness and exercise, but character development as well. Each class includes an anti-bullying and anti-violence component.

Lacrosse Friday 4:10-4:50 Grades 1-3 Lacrosse Friday 4:50-5:30 Grades 4-6

Passing, receiving, shooting and other basic skills will be taught in this entry level program. The program will be conducted indoors and use a mini-stick (provided). Youth to learn the fundamentals of the game while enjoying a rigorous and fun physical activity. Kids that enjoy this introduction to lacrosse can continue during the winter in our Saturday AM clinics held in the Club's lower gym.
